### SECOND READING: EPHESIANS 1:3-14

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens, as he chose us in him, before the foundation of the world, to be holy and without blemish before him. In love he destined us for adoption to himself through Jesus Christ, in accord with the favor of his will, for the praise of the glory of his grace that he granted us in the beloved. In him we have redemption by his blood, the forgiveness of transgressions, in accord with the riches of his grace that he lavished upon us. In all wisdom and insight, he has made known to us the mystery of his will in accord with his favor that he set forth in him as a plan for the fullness of times, to sum up all things in Christ, in heaven and on earth. In him we were also chosen, destined in accord with the purpose of the One who accomplishes all things according to the intention of his will, so that we might exist for the praise of his glory, we who first hoped in Christ. In him you also, who have heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and have believed in him, were sealed with the promised holy Spirit, which is the first installment of our inheritance toward redemption as God's possession, to the praise of his glory.

to wear sandals but not a second tunic. He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave. Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you, leave there and shake the dust off your feet in testimony against them." So they went off and preached repentance. The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them.

**FRI, JUL 16, is the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.** Mount Carmel was a holy place hundreds of years before Christ. There the prophet, Elijah challenged the prophets of the pagan god, Baal, to a contest where the power of God was shown forth. Later, in the early centuries of Christianity, people who wanted to pray and grow close to God settled on the slopes of Mount Carmel. In time, a monastery was built there.

In 1251, the Prior General of the Carmelites, Simon Stock, had a vision of Mary the Mother of God. Today became the special feast day of the Carmelite Order. In the 18th century the feast was extended to the whole church. It is celebrated widely in Italy, where people parade through the streets with a statue of Mary. Italian Americans have kept up the custom.

## Offering Envelopes



### SOME FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE WEEKLY OFFERTORY

- ◆ **Should I make my contribution by check or cash?** Either is fine, and both are appreciated. Using a check does create a safeguard for you and the parish. Checks are endorsed with a “for deposit only” stamp, and are traceable for tax purposes and in case of errors.
- ◆ **Do you want all my envelopes?** If you make your donation once/month or for multiple weeks, you need only ONE ENVELOPE. Donations are recorded the week they are received, whether they are for one week or multiple weeks.
- ◆ **What should I do if I attend a different church sometime?** Hopefully all churches return envelopes to the church of origin. If you have any concern, just wait until you return to your own parish, mail it to the parish office, or drop it in the mail slot at the office.
- ◆ **What if I didn't receive my envelopes?** Just call your parish office. In the meantime, use a plain envelope. Please include your name/church.
- ◆ **Does it matter if I write the amount on my envelope?** YES! Our money-counters verify that the amount written on the envelope is the same as the amount inside it. Contributions are posted on the computer for our records and your tax purposes. This procedure follows IRS and diocesan guidelines.
- ◆ **Who are 2nd collection checks payable to?** Unless directed otherwise, all checks should be made to your home parish. Money taken from a 2nd collection is deposited in the church account, then collectively sent to the diocese. This procedure follows diocesan accounting guidelines.

Ideally, Jubilarians will be invited to join the bishop for a special Golden Wedding Anniversary Mass to be celebrated in Blessed Sacrament Cathedral on SUN, SEP 19.

Though personal circumstances may keep some people from attending the Mass, all registered couples will receive a scroll signed by the bishop commemorating their anniversary.

**INVITATION TO THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER.** After the presider washes his hands, he says, “Pray that our sacrifice may be acceptable to God the almighty Father.” We have brought forward bread and wine, and now we are asked to see in these simple gifts upon the altar a sacrifice offered to God. Our response is rich in theological meaning. “May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your

hands.” The words point to the unique role of the priest, whose hands, at his ordination, were anointed for just this purpose: that he might “sanctify the Christian people and offer sacrifice to God” (*Rite of Ordination*). We ask God to accept our sacrifice “for the praise and glory of his name.” God does not need our offering, but allows us to give it so we might grow in holiness.

And God gives all that we have given back to us, “for our good and the good of all his Church.” This Mass benefits not just those who have gathered, but, in the mysterious economy of grace, the whole Church. In the words of St. Paul, when one part rejoices, the whole body “share[s] its joy” (1 Corinthians 12:26).

### GOD CHOSE US

Who chose first, God or you? That is the question explored in today's three readings. The second reading, from Paul's Letter to the Ephesians, reads almost like a hymn. It praises God for choosing us, for calling us to serve, and for blessing us in our service. Paul makes it clear how honored we are and how special is the call to live as children of God. This is through no doing of our own.

The first reading and the Gospel use prose rather than poetry to describe the same truth: God did the choosing, not us. When the prophet Amos was berated for being a prophet, he retorted that the whole thing wasn't his idea in the first place. Neither did the twelve apostles in today's Gospel ask for their calling. Jesus sent them forth, two by two, to do the work of his kingdom.

**BLESSINGS WITHOUT MEASURE**

Those born into a loving family receive blessings without measure. They are given a name and a nationality. They receive food and drink. They are kept clean and free from danger. They receive a language, a faith, a culture, customs, and an education. The gifts a family bestows cannot be numbered or adequately acknowledged.

As children of God, we have received blessings as well. The Letter to the Ephesians says we were adopted by God through Jesus Christ. We receive forgiveness. And we receive knowledge of the mystery of God's will. This incredible package of gifts is ours due to the goodness of God.

We are used to paying what something is worth and receiving a wage for our work. But once in a while, some merchant does you a favor. You get a rebate. You buy one and get one free. A debt is relaxed. And it feels like the mercy of God has fallen into your lap.

God has given us the greatest gifts freely. Such generosity inspires us to give freely as well. We share our income with those less fortunate - not because they did something for us, but because we want to be kind. We give up our time to help the church or community - not because we cannot pay for a service, but because commitment requires muscles, brains, and patience as well. God has blessed us, and we can share our blessings with the world.


